Sandy Lake Regional Park Coalition (SLRPC) Mission Statement:

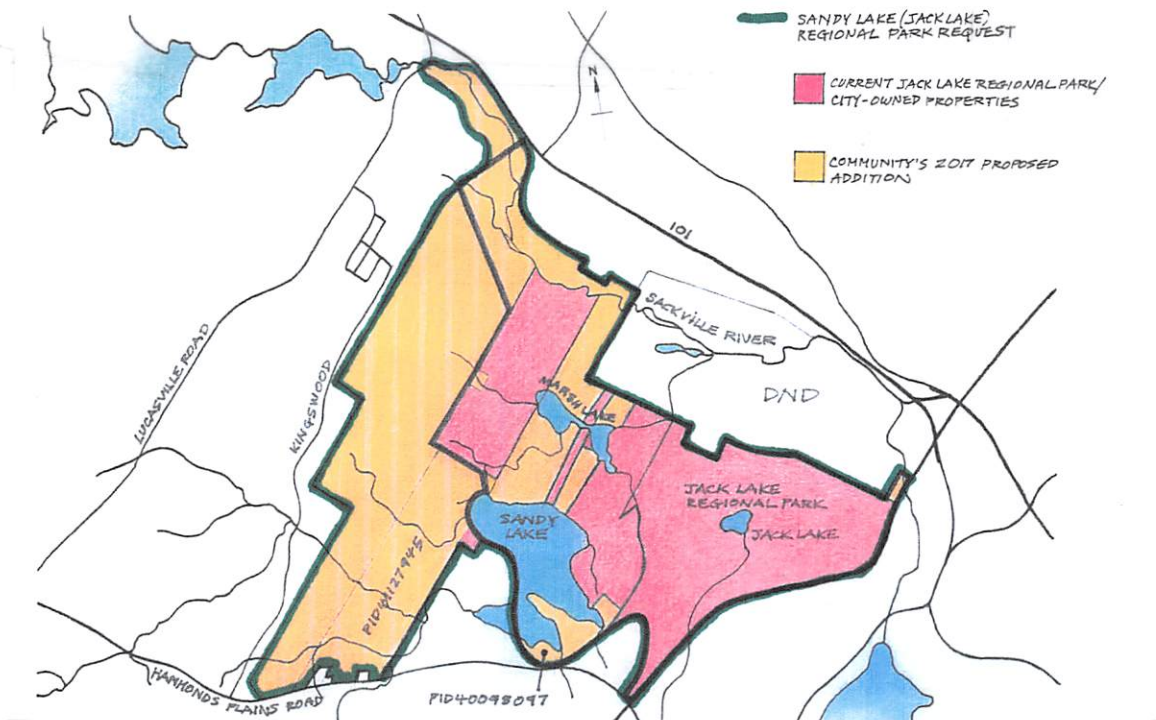
“To preserve and protect over 2000 acres of wildlife and aquatic habitat surrounding the Sandy/Jack/Marsh Lakes and Sackville River area, Bedford, by public ownership, SLRPC will work to acquire by public purchase, land swaps, or other means, a further 1,000 acres to the west and north of Sandy Lake for the enjoyment of the public and protection of the natural environment, for historical, cultural, conservation, educational, and recreational use.

One thousand acres are now in public ownership as a HRM Regional Park. The remaining 1,000 acres are under immense developmental pressures and must be protected immediately.”
